FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Answers to the most common questions about our professional community for clinicians committed to excellence in hearing, balance and neuroinclusive care.



1. WHAT IS HYPATIA SPECIALIST CLINICS?

Hypatia Specialist Clinics is an ongoing professional development community for clinicians working in hearing, vestibular and neuroinclusive healthcare.

We combine peer review, mentorship, governance support, specialist education and collaborative learning to help you continually refine your practice.

Our philosophy is simple:
Exceptional patient care begins with exceptional clinicians.



2. WHO CAN JOIN?

Membership is open to healthcare professionals with an interest in hearing, balance and neuroinclusive practice, including:

- Audiologists
- Vestibular Specialists
- ENT & Audio-Vestibular Physicians
- Physiotherapists
- Occupational Therapists
- Speech & Language Therapists
- Clinical Scientists
- Rehabilitation Specialists
- Students and newly qualified clinicians
- Experienced consultants

The programme is multidisciplinary and welcomes a range of perspectives.



3. WHAT HAPPENS DURING THE MONTHLY PEER REVIEW MEETINGS?

Each month we meet to discuss real clinical cases in a confidential, supportive environment.

Sessions may include complex presentations, differential diagnosis, management strategies, interpretation of investigations, rehabilitation planning, clinical reasoning, report writing and more.

The emphasis is on shared learning, reflective practice and continual improvement – not criticism.



4. DO I HAVE TO PRESENT MY OWN CASES?

No. Many members initially join to observe and learn from colleagues.

You are welcome to simply listen until you feel comfortable contributing. Participation is always voluntary – there is never any obligation to present.



5. WHAT RESOURCES ARE INCLUDED?

Members have access to a continually expanding library of professional resources, including: SOPs, governance templates, audit tools, patient information leaflets, clinical pathways, assessment templates, report examples, research summaries, evidence updates, clinical checklists, and practical tools to support high-quality practice.



6. WILL I HAVE ACCESS TO HYPATIA TRAINING COURSES?

Members receive access to exclusive educational content, early release opportunities and preferential pricing on selected Hypatia Training Experiences.

The educational content available will continue to grow as the Academy develops.



7. CAN THE PROGRAMME HELP ME DEVELOP MY OWN SPECIALIST CLINIC?

Yes. We support clinicians who wish to establish or grow specialist services through advice and resources on service development, clinical pathways, governance systems, equipment selection, patient journeys, documentation, workflow optimisation and quality improvement.



8. IS THE PROGRAMME SUITABLE FOR NEWLY QUALIFIED CLINICIANS?

Absolutely. Newly qualified clinicians benefit from mentorship, structured peer review and a supportive community. Experienced clinicians also value the opportunity to discuss complex cases and share knowledge with peers.



9. IS THERE A MINIMUM MEMBERSHIP PERIOD?

No. Membership operates on a rolling monthly subscription with no long-term contract. You are free to remain a member for as long as the programme continues to support your professional development.



10. CAN I CANCEL MY MEMBERSHIP?

Yes. Membership can be cancelled at any time. Your subscription will end at the close of your current billing period. You are always welcome to rejoin whenever space is available.



11. WILL I RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE?

Educational activities completed through Hypatia Training Experiences include certificates of completion. The Specialist Clinics membership focuses on ongoing professional development and reflective practice rather than a single certification event.



12. IS THIS CPD ACCREDITED?

Many educational activities within Hypatia are designed to support Continuing Professional Development (CPD). Where formal accreditation applies, this will be clearly stated for the individual course or event.
